



A Blueball Design Responsive Sandvox Design

Customizing Blueball Slider Design User Guide v2.0.

The Blueball Slider design layout is very customizable.

The Blueball Slider responsive Sandvox design and its css code, is set up to allow users to customize many aspects of its responsive layout elements using Sandvox's Site Code Injection (applied site wide) or Page Code Injection (applied to one page).

Listed below are some of the most popular items to customize on the Slider design to get you started.

Some important items to note in general before you get started:

You MUST be connected to the Internet while working on your Sandvox site when using the Blueball Slider design due to calls made to Google fonts, Font Awesome icons, and jQuery for your Slider Responsive design's display functionality. **Make sure that you have the "While Editing: Load data from the Internet" box checked in Sandvox's Preferences window.**

You will need to use the Site Code Injection or Page Code Injection feature in Sandvox to customize elements in the Slider responsive design layout by pasting in css code supplied in this document into the Style Sheet window in Site Code Injection. It's not hard at all to do and just involves going to **Edit > Site Code Injection** and opening up the Site Code Injection window.

Or **Edit > Page Code** Injection and opening up the Page Code Injection window. **You can find out more on Site and Page Code Injection in Sandvox here:** http://www.karelia.com/support/sandvox/help/z/Code_Injection.html

The css code shown in bold and orange below each element description in this document is what you need to select, copy, and then paste using the code injection of your choosing. Once you paste the code in place, refresh your page view in Sandvox (Command + R keys) to see the code applied to your site page display.

That's it. While virtually every layout element in the Blueball Slider responsive design can be customized to some extent, we only list the most popular items below for you to use and edit on your Sandvox site pages.

How to customize page layout items in Blueball Slider.

Please find various Blueball Slider design elements listed below to customize. **Be sure to ONLY copy the custom code in orange below each item for pasting into the Site (or Page) Code Injection window in Sandvox.**

Color hexcodes used in the Blueball Slider designs.

The 14 Sandvox design version colors are for the most part set using 6-digit hexcodes to specify the colors used in each design.

Below is a list of the colors used in the 14 Blueball Slider responsive designs and their 6-digit highlight color hexcodes listed to the right.

How to modify the mobile nav "Menu" text.

By default the word beside the menu icon in the mobile nav menu layout is "Menu". You can change this easily by using the following custom css code in the Style Sheets window using Site Code Injection. **Adjust the word "Menu" in code below as needed to suit your language or need.**

--- Custom css code to edit, copy and paste in orange below---

@media (max-width: 768px) {  
#nav:before {content: "\f0c9  Menu";}

```

Change Google font styles from default fonts.

The Blueball Slider responsive design offers 15 custom Google font styles for you to use and mix and match on your site pages. The default font styles used are PT Sans for the headlines and Lato for the content text. You can easily modify the font style combinations by using some custom css.

The 15 custom Google font styles available in Blueball Slider design are: Amatic SC, Crimson Text, Glegoo, Great Vibes, Lato, Lobster, Montserrat, Neucha, Playball, PT Serif, Roboto, Roboto Condensed, Roboto Slab, Rubik, and Source Serif Pro.

Examples of the Blueball Slider 15 Google font styles.

I thought it would help Sandvox users out to be able to see the different font styles before deciding on which ones to use for your Blueball Slider design site's headline and content text font styles.

Amatic SC *font weights: 400, 700, regular*

Crimson Text *font weights: 400, 600, 700, regular/italic*

The quick brown fox jumped over the lazy dog.

Glegoo *font weights: 400, 700, regular*

Great Vibes *font weights: 400, regular*

The quick brown fox jumped over the lazy dog.

Lato *font weights: 300, 400, 700, 900, regular/italic*

The quick brown fox jumped over the lazy dog.

Roboto Condensed *font weights: 300, 400, 700, regular/italic*

The quick brown fox jumped over the lazy dog.

Roboto Slab *font weights: 300, 400, 700, regular*

The quick brown fox jumped over the lazy dog.

Source Serif Pro *font weights: 400, 600, 700, regular/italic*

Rubik *font weights: 300, 400, 500, 600, 700, 900, regular/italic*

PT Serif *font weights: 400, 700, regular/italic*

**What font weights mean: 300 = Light, 400 = Book/Regular, 500 = Medium, 600 = Semi-bold, 700 = Bold, 900 = Black*

How to change the headline (h tagged text) font style.

To adjust the headline font styles including blockquote text, use the css code listed below for each available Google font style. We recommend using just one Google font style for your headline (h tagged) text in your web site for maximizing viewer impact and site continuity.

Amatic SC

How to change the content font style.

To adjust the content font style including nav menu text, use the css code listed below for each available Google font style. We recommend using just one Google font style for your content text in your web site for maximizing viewer impact and site continuity.

How to change the color of the Title text.

To change the color of the Title text, add the following css code to the Style Sheet window using Site Code Injection, adjusting the 6 digit hexcode to the color you want to use. The default orange #fd5308 hexcode color is shown below.

--- Custom css code to edit, copy and paste in orange below---

```
#title h1, #title h1 a {color: #fd5308;}
```

How to change the font size of the Title text.

The Blueball Slider design sets the font sizing of the Title text not only for desktop browsers, but also for tablets and smartphone devices too using media query breakpoint widths.

You cannot use the font resizing option in Sandvox to resize the Title text because when you do, Sandvox places inline css styling into the page's source code to size the Title text which overrides all font sizing specified in the Slider design's main.css file for all devices. So for example if you resized the Title text to be 60px using Sandvox, that text will display at 60px on desktop, tablet and smartphone browsers alike.

If you must resize the Title text, then do so by using the following custom css code:

--- Custom css code to edit, copy and paste in orange below---

```
#title h1 {font-size: 56px; line-height: 56px;}  
@media only screen and (max-width: 768px) {  
#title h1 {font-size: 42px; line-height: 42px;}  
}  
@media only screen and (max-width: 480px) {  
#title h1 {font-size: 36px; line-height:36px;}  
}
```

How to change the color of the Tagline text.

To change the color of the Tagline text, add the following css code to the Style Sheet window using Site Code Injection, adjusting the 6 digit hexcode to the color you want to use. The default dark gray #333333 hexcode color is shown below.

--- Custom css code to edit, copy and paste in orange below---

```
#title #tagline {color: #333333;}
```

How to change the font size of the Title text.

The Blueball Slider design sets the font sizing of the Title text not only for desktop browsers, but also for tablets and smartphone devices too using media query breakpoint widths.

You cannot use the font resizing option in Sandvox to resize the Title text because when you do, Sandvox places inline css styling into the page's source code to size the Title text which overrides all font sizing specified in the Slider design's main.css file for all devices. So for example if you resized the Title text to be 30px using Sandvox, that text will display at 30px on desktop, tablet and smartphone browsers alike.

If you must resize the Title text, then do so by using the following custom css code:

--- Custom css code to edit, copy and paste in orange below---

#title #tagline {font-size: 22px; line-height:26px;}  
@media only screen and (max-width: 768px) {  
#title #tagline {font-size: 18px; line-height:22px;}  
}  
@media only screen and (max-width: 480px) {  
#title #tagline {font-size: 16px; line-height:20px;}  
}
```

How to hide header slideshow display on one site page.

By default there is no slideshow displayed on site pages initially in the Blueball Slider design layout. If you have added in a site-wide header slideshow into your site using one of the methods detailed in the directions below, and want to hide the slideshow on a single site page here's how. Open up Page Code Injection and enter the following css code into the bottom field area in the Page Code Injection "Head Area" tab window:

--- Custom css code to edit, copy and paste in orange below---

```
<style type="text/css" media="all">  
#slideBanner {display:none;}  
</style>
```

How to add a header slideshow to your site pages.

We provide a separate user guide for adding a header slideshow into your Blueball Slider Sandvox site that came with your download. This file is called **slider-slideshow-setup-v1.5.pdf**.

Please see it for complete information on how to setup and add a site-wide header slideshow or separate header slideshows on each of your site pages. You can use our 50+ preset slideshow banner images or your own custom slideshow banner images.

How to change the body background color.

To change the color of the body background on your Blueball Slider site layout, open up Site Code Injection and add the following css code into the Style Sheet window. The default body background white #ffffff hexcode is shown below:

--- Custom css code to edit, copy and paste in orange below---

body {background-color: #ffffff;}
```

How much you customize your Blueball Slider responsive design Sandvox site is completely up to you.

You can choose to customize the look of your Blueball Slider responsive site however much you want to, or go with it as is out -of-the-box with no customization at all. You are not required to modify and customize anything on the Slider responsive designs to have a great looking modern Google "mobile-friendly" web site.

This readme file is meant to be a guide offering tips and css code for those Sandvox users who might want to personalize the look and feel of the Slider responsive designs a little more to make it their own unique design layout.
